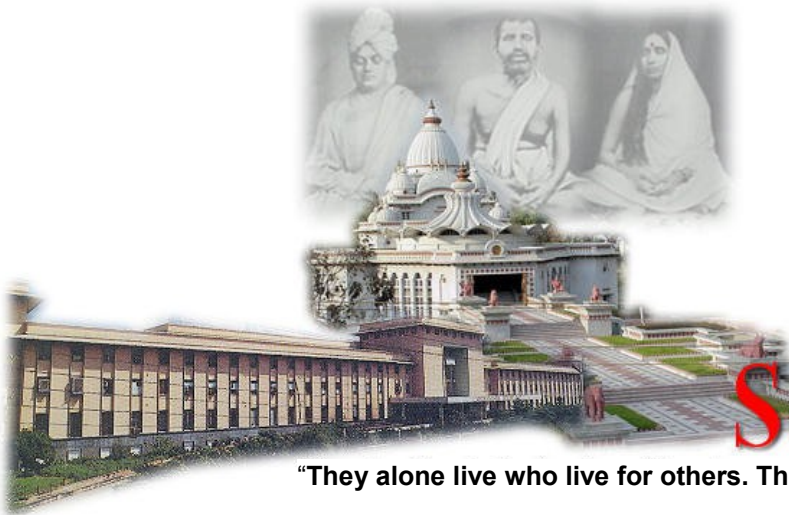

Inauguration of High End Phaco Machine Infiniti

Srimat Swami Suhitanandji Maharaj, General Secretary, Ramakrishna Math & Ramakrishna Mission, Belur Math, Howrah inaugurated a High End Phaco Machine Infiniti at the newly built Eye O.T. of Vivekananda Polyclinic & Institute of Medical Sciences (VPIMS), Lucknow on 14th September 2013 in presence of Monastic Brothers, Senior Administrative Officers, Ophthalmology Consultants and Paramedical Staff as well as large number of eye-patients of the Institute.

The 4th generation Phaco Machine-the latest of its kind is fully automatic machine which enables the Eye Surgeon to perform Cataract Surgeries with high speed and fine precision in best visual recovery in a short span of time. It is hoped that with this machine we shall be able to provide much better services to the needy with excellent visual outcome and affordable cost.

The Ophthalmology Department of the VPIMS, Lucknow is well equipped with all the modern facilities to take care of the various visual needs of eye patients. The department performs nearly 3000 cataract operations annually, 80% of which are totally free of cost.



Cyto-Pathology Conference

Dr. Padam K. Agarwal, Sr. Consultant in Pathology and DNB Coordinator, VPIMS Lucknow and founder Cyto-Pathology delivered a key note address on Brain & Thyroid Cancer at the Cyto-Pathology Workshop Held at KGMU, Lucknow on 15.09.2013. She said that the field of Cyto-Pathology is being continuously updated and with this technique Brain and Thyroid Cancers can be easily identified by microscopic examination of the few cells obtained from the diseased tissue without doing any biopsy and the definite line of treatment of patients can be decided by the doctors. The Secretary congratulated her for being a dedicated Pathologist and hoped that the DNB students will gain proficiency their courses under her guidance.

Smile Train Workshop:



A workshop was held at VPIMS, Lucknow on 25-26 August 2013, by **Dr. Arun Gosain, Member-Medical Advisory Board, Smile Train USA and Plastic Surgeon, Lurie Children Hospital, Boston.** He delivered a talk on **“Repair of Secondary Cleft Nasal Deformities”** followed by a live demonstration of **06 operations.** He also appreciated the work being done under smile train project which is comparable with the international standards. Dr Vaibhav Khanna, Visiting Consultant and HOD Department of Plastic and Craniofacial Surgery, VPIMS, Lucknow informed that approximately 60,000 children have already been operated in our institute free of cost with excellent results. He added that the latest surgical techniques

demonstrated will help us in providing better treatment to the patients.

Medical Camps

Obesity and Pain Management Camp: A 6 day-long camp on Obesity and Pain Management Camp was organized at VPIMS, Lucknow by the Department of Yoga & Naturopathy from **16 to 21 September 2013.** A total of **79 patients** attended the camp, out of which **30 patients** of Cervical/Lumbar Spondylitis, Arthritis & Obesity were selected for treatment.

Yoga Camp: A Yoga Camp for **15** days was organized by the Department of Yoga and Naturopathy, VPIMS, Lucknow from 23 September to 8 October **2013** onwards. A total of **14 participants** were trained in various Yoga, Pranayama and Meditation Practices towards ensuring Holistic Health.

Health Awareness Camp on PCOS: A health awareness camp on Poly Cystic Ovarian Syndrome (PCOS) was organised on 10 September 2013 by Dr. Vaishali Jain, Visiting Consultant, Gynaecologist, VPIMS, Lucknow. 40 participants attended an audio visual presentation which included Consultants, DNB Doctors & Nursing Staff of the Institute.

Oral Cancer Awareness: Dr. Neeraj Tandon, Visiting Consultant Oncologist, VPIMS, Lucknow delivered a series of audio visual presentation on Oral Cancer Awareness in the various schools and colleges of Lucknow, explaining the ill effects of tobacco. He also presented cases with pre-malignant and cancer lesions. A camp on Oral Cancer Awareness was also held at BIJVA (Lakhimpur Khiri District) which was attended by 500 patients/villagers.
